Registration

- Please turn in registration forms and camp fees for Cub Scouts and Adult Leaders at the same time. Make checks payable to Greater Yosemite Council. Hand carry or mail them to the Modesto Scout Office, 4031 Technology Drive, Modesto, CA 95356. **ATTN: Cub Day Camp Registration.**
- Please fill out **SEPARATE** registration forms for Cub Scouts, Leaders, Tag-A-longs and Den Chiefs/Aides.
- Registration is on a first come-first serve basis. Some camps are limited in size and may fill up quickly.
- NO walk-ins will be accepted. Late registrations will be accepted until 14 days before camp **only if space is still available at the camp.** You can **call the Camp Director any time before camp opens and inquire about this.**
- **Scout Bucks** earned from Council fundraisers may be used toward the cost of Day Camp. If you have not received them yet, you may make a deposit to **reserve a spot at Day Camp.** See below.
- **CAMPERSHIPS** are available for Scouts with financial need. Deadline: Friday, April 27, 2008. Information and forms are available at the **Atwater Service Center**, 2250 Linden Avenue, 209-356-1215, **Modesto Service Center**, 4031 Technology Drive, 209-545-6320, and **Stockton Service Center**, 1545 St. Mark's Plaza, Suite #7, 209-472-9960.

Registration Deadlines

- **Early Bird Registration** **\$50 (\$55 for Tracy and Stockton Camp)**
 Must be paid in full 45 days before camp begins **Soccer Day Camp registration**
- **On-Time Registration** **\$55 (\$60 for Tracy and Stockton Camp)** **fees are \$10**
 Must be paid in full 30 days before camp begins.
- **Late Registration** **\$75 (\$80 for Tracy Camp)**
 When paid in full less than 30 days before camp begins.

Reserve a Spot at Day Camp **\$10 Non-refundable deposit**

- Your deposit will **GUARANTEE** a place for your Cub Scout at Day Camp, provided full payment is made by the on-time date or until Scout Bucks are received. The deposit may be applied to late registration **IF THERE IS STILL SPACE AVAILABLE AT CAMP.**

- **RANK at DAY CAMP:** Cub Scouts register at the rank level they will be working on as school begins in the Summer/Fall of 2008. Cub Scouts who graduate to the next rank before camp should register to attend camp at the new rank.
- Packs sponsored by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (LDS) register by age rather than by grade. However, if a Scout's birthday falls during the summer and he has already achieved his rank and arrow points for that age, he may choose to attend camp at the next rank level.
- **GRADES and AGES:** Tiger 1st. Grade Adult partner **MUST** attend at **ALL** times
 Wolf 2nd. Grade or 8 years old (LDS units)
 Bear 3rd. Grade or 9 years old (LDS units)
 Webelos 4th. & 5th Grade or 10 years old (LDS units)
- **VOLUNTEER STAFF.** The staff at our Cub Scout Day Camps is completely made up of volunteers. We need your help to meet BSA requirements for two-deep leadership!! Each unit **MUST** send **ONE** full-time adult volunteer for each **FIVE** boys that attend camp, with a minimum of **TWO** leaders for any pack that sends **FOUR** or more Cub Scouts. 1-3 Cub Scouts= 1 adult; 4-10 Cub Scouts= 2 adults; 11-15 Cub Scouts= 3 adults; 16-20 Cub Scouts= 4 adults; etc. **No exceptions! If your Pack does not provide enough leaders, your Scouts cannot attend camp.**

Call the Director after the camp closure date to find out is space is still available.
