



## A NEW VISION OF YOUTH LEADERSHIP

**Browsea-National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is brand new!** The course is new, the name is new, the staff is new and there is a new enthusiasm for this youth leadership training. Scouting recognizes that Scoutmasters have the primary responsibility for training their youth leaders. The purpose of NYLT is not to assume that role, but rather to support it. NYLT features instruction in skills that can be used at home, at school, on the job, and, in particular, at the Scout unit level. Through activities, events, games, and adventures, NYLT participants will work hard and play hard together as they put into action the best Scouting has to offer.

### COURSE OVERVIEW:

- A month in the life of an adult led, boy run troop
- The course centers on the concepts that a leader must *BE*, what he must *KNOW*, and what he must *DO*. The key elements are then taught with a focus on *HOW TO*.
- Experiencing the stages of team development in a patrol
- Leadership requires vision, goals and planning
- A ‘toolbox’ of leadership skills
- Consistent leadership modeling utilizing the Scout Oath and Scout Law



### OBJECTIVES:

- Give participants the confidence and knowledge to conduct the troop program.
- Provide participants with a clear understanding of how to lead themselves and others in their troop and patrol with a “vision” of future success by goal setting, planning and problem solving.
- Guide the participants through the use of the “stages of team development” to reach their full potential.
- Create an environment of Scouting fellowship and fun guided by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experiences with Scouts from other troops.
- NYLT offers leadership, fun, challenge and adventure.

### PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS:

- At least 13 years of age, but not yet 18 by the June 12, 2005.
- Highly recommended Scouts attend Scoutmaster or District JLT prior to attending Browsea.
- At least First Class rank.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Scout Law at all times.
- Attend the Scoutmaster pre-conference along with their parents and scoutmaster to be held from 9 am to 5 pm on May 14, at the Modesto Scout Center.
- Check-In time at Camp John Mensinger is 10:00 am June 12, 2005.
- The cost of training is \$175.00 by May 1, 2005. A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit is required by April 1, 2005.
